Highlights from the May 11<sup>th</sup> OPPG Leadership Meeting and the May 18<sup>th</sup> OPPG Parent Meeting:

- We are very happy to introduce the new OPPG Board for 2010-2011. All members ran unopposed, and they have been approved by the Executive Board. June will be a transition month between the old and new Boards, and the new Board's terms begin officially on July 1. Thank you to all the nominees!

- Rhonda & Jexy gave the OCS Board report. The school calendar is still on hold waiting for PUSD's calendar to be published. If any parents have opinions on the length of breaks or the start of the school year before Labor Day, please come to the May Board meeting or contact Rhonda or Jexy. There is a preliminary budget, which will be reviewed at the May Board meeting.

- Arts Committee is also working on bringing youTHink to OCS. This is a division of the Zimmer Museum, and would provide arts lessons to 4<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grades in June.

- Parents voted on how much OPPG would be able to give OCS at the end of the year. Our anticipated balance after our June fundraisers is approximately \$44,000. There was discussion about leaving a larger amount in our OPPG account so that we could consider funding something special next year (like a field trip). A motion was made by Neil to keep \$9K in OPPG's account, and give the rest (approx \$35K – TBD at June's Leadership meeting) to OCS, with the understanding that we hope the amount we are giving over what was expected can be used for more TAs, and that if there is a line item in the budget that is dependent on a few more thousand, that we would like OCS to come to us to ask for more. Rhonda seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved by the 21 parents in attendance.
- Have you donated to the Silent Auction basket in your classroom? Each classroom is putting together a basket, so see your Room parent and contribute! Help make our Casino Night Silent Auction a success!
