How It Works

Boxes of fresh, locally grown pesticide-free produce will be delivered to Odyssey each week by equitableroots, a social enterprise committed to providing affordable access to locally grown, fresh produce.

By subscribing you support Odyssey and a healthful lifestyle for your family. Three dollars from each box stays with Odyssey to help support the school. It's a good thing all around – good for your family, good for your school, good for local farmers, and good for our community!



How Do I Sign Up?

Produce boxes are purchased prior to delivery by going directly to www.shop.equitableroots.com. The weekly rate is \$18.00 per box. You will have the option of pre-purchasing up to four weeks in advance. All payments are handled online. E-mail reminders for pick-ups will be sent each week.

Where do I pick up my Box?

Starting Thursday, June 2, you can pick up your box each Thursday for the remainder of the school year in the teacher's lounge from 2:30 – 4pm.

What's in my Box?

Contents vary each week and will contain a diverse assortment of fresh fruits and vegetables. A typical cool season box may contain: apples, tangerines, broccoli, carrots, onions, potatoes, and kale. An added bonus comes in the form of a weekly newsletter e-mailed directly to you. Each newsletter profiles a local farmer and provides recipes and ideas on how to cook and serve up the fresh produce.
